Honoring Allen Ginsberg's Contributions to American Literature

First Prize: \$2,000 Second Prize: \$1,000 Third Prize: \$500

Winners will be expected to participate in a reading to take place in the Paterson Historic District.

CONTEST RULES:

- 1. Up to five <u>unpublished</u> poems per person will be accepted for consideration.
- 2. **Three copies** of each poem should be submitted for distribution to the judges.
- 3. Each poem should be no longer than two manuscript pages.
- 4. Pages with poems should not include the poet's name; instead a separate cover sheet should list the poet's name, mailing address, phone number, e-mail address and poem titles.
- 5. Poems cannot be returned. Please do not submit poems that imitate Allen Ginsberg's work.
- 6. A check for \$18.00 payable to PCCC must accompany submission (write "Poetry Contest" in memo section of the check). There is a \$55 bounced check fee for checks returned for insufficient funds.
- 7. **Deadline: February 1, 2024** (postmarked).
- 8. Winners will be announced in spring 2024 at www.poetrycenterpccc.com. Winning poems will be published in the *Paterson Literary Review*.
